Registration/Bid Number: You will receive a nametag with your bid number on it. Use the number assigned to you when signing up for Great Gathering parties and bidding on Silent Auction items.

Great Gathering Parties: To sign up for a Gathering party, write your name and bid number on the sheet in front of the display. PLEASE WRITE ONE NAME PER LINE on the Sign-Up sheets. For example, if you and your spouse sign up for a party, you will EACH need to sign your name on a SEPARATE line – not together on one line.

<u>Silent Auction:</u> Please enter your name and bid number when bidding on a silent auction item. Please take note of the starting bid for each item and the minimum incremental bid increases that are listed on each sheet. The silent auction will close at 8:30pm.

Payment: Please check in at the registration table with your credit card. Payments for all items purchased will be charged to your credit card after the event. An invoice will be mailed to your home listing the total charges made to your card. You will also receive a list of the Great gathering parties you signed up for, any silent auction items or raffle tickets you purchased.
