No-gluten reception of Communion, the Blood of Christ, is available for those recieving from the cup minister closest to the musicians first. Then all others may drink from that cup.


Low-gluten hosts are available upon request from any bread minister. Low-gluten hosts are consecrated in a separate pyx.

verse 1 I will bless the Lord at all times, praise of God is always in my mouth. In the Lord my soul shall make its boast; the humble shall hear and be glad.


verse 2 Glorify the Lord with me; together let us praise God's name. I sought the Lord, and God answered me; from all my terrors God set me free.

HOMILY

PROFESSION OF FAITH - THE NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.







Lamb of God




INVITATION TO COMMUNION
