If you would like to become a member of our parish, please stop by the **Welcome** and **Registration Table** in the O'Gara Gathering Space.



A nursery for children walking age to preschool age is available during the 9 a.m. and 11a.m. liturgies. It is located in Room 106 of the school. It is free of charge.


**Hearing devices** are available for use during Mass. They can be found in the Vesting Room near the font. Ushers can assist you.

verse 4 Your right hand saves me. The Lord will complete what has been done for me; Your kindness, O Lord, endures forever; forsake not the work of your hands.



#### Invitation to Communion


PRESIDER: Behold the Lamb of God,

the Father, and the Son, + and the Holy Spirit.


